

Westernport Quilters Inc. Quilt Show 17th and 18th March 2018

To make our show a huge success we need to exhibit our very best work. I know many of you are working on stunning new pieces for the show.

Kit quilts, block of the month, art quilts and appliqué, jackets and bags can all be displayed. ***The bigger the variety the better.*** Your items can also be for sale. (*10% of the sale price to be paid to Westernport Quilters Inc*)

What constitutes a quilt?

A quilt is made up of 3 layers. The quilt top can be either pieced or whole cloth but must be stitched through all three layers and the outer raw edges must be covered by binding.

The quilts are not going to be judged for prizes.

Please supply a photograph of each item for the exhibition with a name on the reverse side.

An entry form is required for each item entered. *A maximum of 3 items per member*

Conditions of entry

All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor either original or from a commercial pattern. If you wish to sell your work and it has been made from a commercial pattern, make sure the pattern has no sale restrictions.

Appliqué designs and logos from copyrighted material eg: Olympic rings, Disney characters etc will not be accepted unless written permission is supplied. Unauthorised use of copyrighted material is an offence.

All exhibits must be clean, free of lint & stray threads, pet hair, pins and needles.

Each exhibit must be labelled with the name of the maker. The quilt title is optional.

All quilts must have a hanging sleeve with a depth of 4" except for miniatures where 2" is enough.

Each quilt must have a labelled fabric quilt bag.

Due to the size of the stands we will only be able to accept quilts no greater than 96 inches square.

Westernport Quilters will take reasonable care but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.

Insurance of quilts is the exhibitors' responsibility

Exhibits will be displayed at the organiser's discretion. A maximum of 3 items per member will be accepted. If the number of quilts exceeds the space available the number of entries may be limited to 2.

Westernport Quilters Inc reserves the right to photograph and reproduce entries for publicity purposes

Completed entry forms must be returned to Westernport Quilters Inc PO box 163 Tyabb 3913 or handed in at our monthly meeting by the 16th January 2018.

Quilts must be delivered to Tyabb Community Hall between 9.30 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. Friday 16th March.

Exhibitors or their agent are requested to collect their work from the Tyabb hall between 4pm – 5 pm on Sunday 18th March. If anyone other than the owner is collecting a quilt after the show they must produce written permission from the owner.
